

## GETTING HERE

### *Car & Parking*



Cabot Circus Car Park has over 2600 spaces and is easily accessible from the end of the M32.

- The postcode - for sat nav users - is BS2 9AB (upload the latest maps from your service provider).
- A Cabot Circus car park is open 24/7.
- Disabled bays are available on the ground and third floors.
- Parent & Toddler bays are available on the ground floor, second floor, third floor and fourth floors.
- Electric car bays with chargers are available on the first and second floors.

There are also a number of alternative car parks within easy walking distance, which are labelled on the map.

### *Bus/Coach*



Cabot Circus is well served by local bus services and the national coach network.

- Bus stops for the majority of local bus services are located close to Cabot Circus and in the Haymarket a short walk away.
- All bus services in Bristol pass through or terminate at the city centre.
- Bristol Bus Station is nearby providing bus links to South Gloucestershire, North Somerset, Somerset, Bath, Wiltshire and South Wales as well as Bristol International Airport and the national coach network.

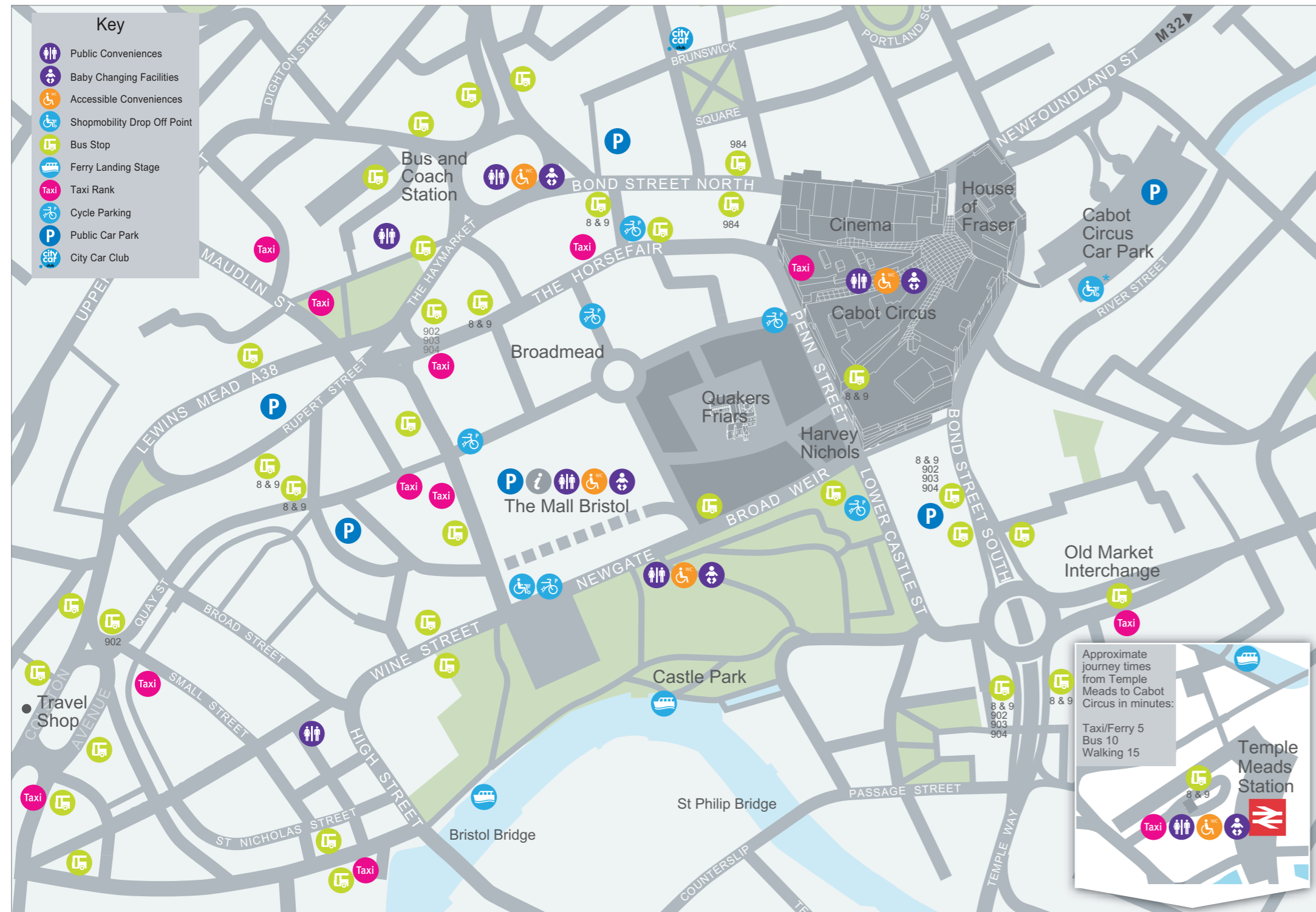

### Park & Ride

Cabot Circus is extremely easy to get to by Park & Ride. Park for free and simply pay for your bus fare.

- Buses run every 10–20 mins from 902 Portway, 903 Long Ashton and 904 Bath Road Monday to Saturday.
- The 984 Cabot Circus Park & Ride from UWE Car Park runs every Saturday and Sunday from 27 September until 28th December 2008. Buses operate every 15 mins.

### Train

There are direct train services to Bristol Temple Meads from Cardiff, Gloucester, Cheltenham, Bath, Chippenham, Swindon, Reading, London, Weston-Super-Mare, Taunton and Westbury. Cabot Circus is only a short walk from the station (see insert on map).

Bus services 8/9A or 9/9A and the ferry provide a direct link between Bristol Temple Meads and Cabot Circus.

### Ferry

Enjoy this unique alternative route by ferry from Bristol Temple Meads to Cabot Circus.

- The stop for Cabot Circus is Castle Park.
- A return trip costs £2
- This service runs every 10 mins, with 5 mins journey time.
- Service hours are from: Monday – Saturday 10am – 6pm  
Sunday 11am – 5pm
- This service will run until 31st December 2008.

### Foot or Bike

Bristol Legible City is a unique concept that provides pedestrians with clear direction signs and maps to make negotiating the journey to Cabot Circus easy. Cycle parking stands are provided close to Cabot Circus.

### Taxi

The closest taxi rank is on Penn Street, immediately adjacent to Cabot Circus. Other ranks are located at Temple Meads, Bristol Bus and Coach Station and several others within easy walking distance.

### Air

Bristol International Airport is located several miles south of Bristol. Cabot Circus is easily accessible by bus or taxi.

### Shopmobility

Shopmobility is a scheme providing shoppers who have mobility impairments, with powered or manual scooters and wheelchairs.

- Shopmobility is located at unit 26 in The Mall Bristol, near TK Maxx. This will soon move to the ground floor of the Cabot Circus car park, where a range of scooters and wheelchairs are currently available.
- Opening hours are 10am – 5pm Monday to Saturday.
- The service costs £1 per hour, or £5 for the day.

### Dial-A-Ride

Provides a door-to-door service for those with disabilities or unable to use public transport due to mobility impairments.

- This service will take you directly to Cabot Circus.
- Service hours are from: Monday – Thursday 9am – 5pm  
Friday 9am – 4.30pm
- A single journey costs from £1.10 - £1.60. All England card concessionary holders travel for free.
