

Travel Guide



_Car & Parking

Cabot Circus Car Park has over 2500 spaces and is easily accessible from the end of the M32.

- The postcode - for sat nav users - is BS2 9AB (upload the latest maps from your service provider).
- The Cabot Circus car park is open 24/7.
- Disabled bays are available on the ground and third floors.
- Parent & Toddler bays are available on the ground floor, second floor, third floor and fourth floors.

_Bus/Coach

Cabot Circus is well served by local bus services and the national coach network.

- Bus stops for the majority of local bus services are located close to Cabot Circus and in the Haymarket a short walk away.
- All bus services in Bristol pass through or terminate at the city centre.
- Bristol Bus Station is nearby providing bus links to South Gloucestershire, North Somerset, Somerset, Bath, Wiltshire and South Wales as well as Bristol International Airport and the national coach network.

_Train

There are direct train services to Bristol Temple Meads from Cardiff, Gloucester, Cheltenham, Bath, Chippenham, Swindon, Reading, London, Weston-Super-Mare, Taunton and Westbury. Cabot Circus is only a short walk from the station (see insert on map).

Bus services 8/9A or 9/9A and the ferry provide a direct link between Bristol Temple Meads and Cabot Circus.

_Taxi

The closest taxi rank is on Penn Street, immediately adjacent to Cabot Circus. Other ranks are located at Temple Meads, Bristol Bus and Coach Station and several others within easy walking distance.

_Park & Ride

Cabot Circus is extremely easy to get to by Park & Ride. Park for free and simply pay for your bus fare.

- Buses run every 10–20 mins from 902 Portway, 903 Long Ashton and 904 Bath Road Monday to Saturday.

_Foot or Bike

Bristol Legible City is a unique concept that provides pedestrians with clear direction signs and maps to make negotiating the journey to Cabot Circus easy. Cycle parking stands are provided close to Cabot Circus.

_Ferry

Experience a unique way to travel to Cabot Circus by catching a ferry from Bristol Temple Meads train station to the Castle Park stop. Ferries leave on a regular basis and take less than 10 minutes to reach Castle Park. Cabot Circus is a very short walk away. _Shopmobility

Shopmobility is a scheme providing shoppers who have mobility impairments, with powered or manual scooters and wheelchairs.

- This service is located on the ground floor of the Cabot Circus car park,
 - Opening hours are 10am – 5pm Monday to Saturday.
 - The cost for hire is £1 per hour, or £5 for the day.

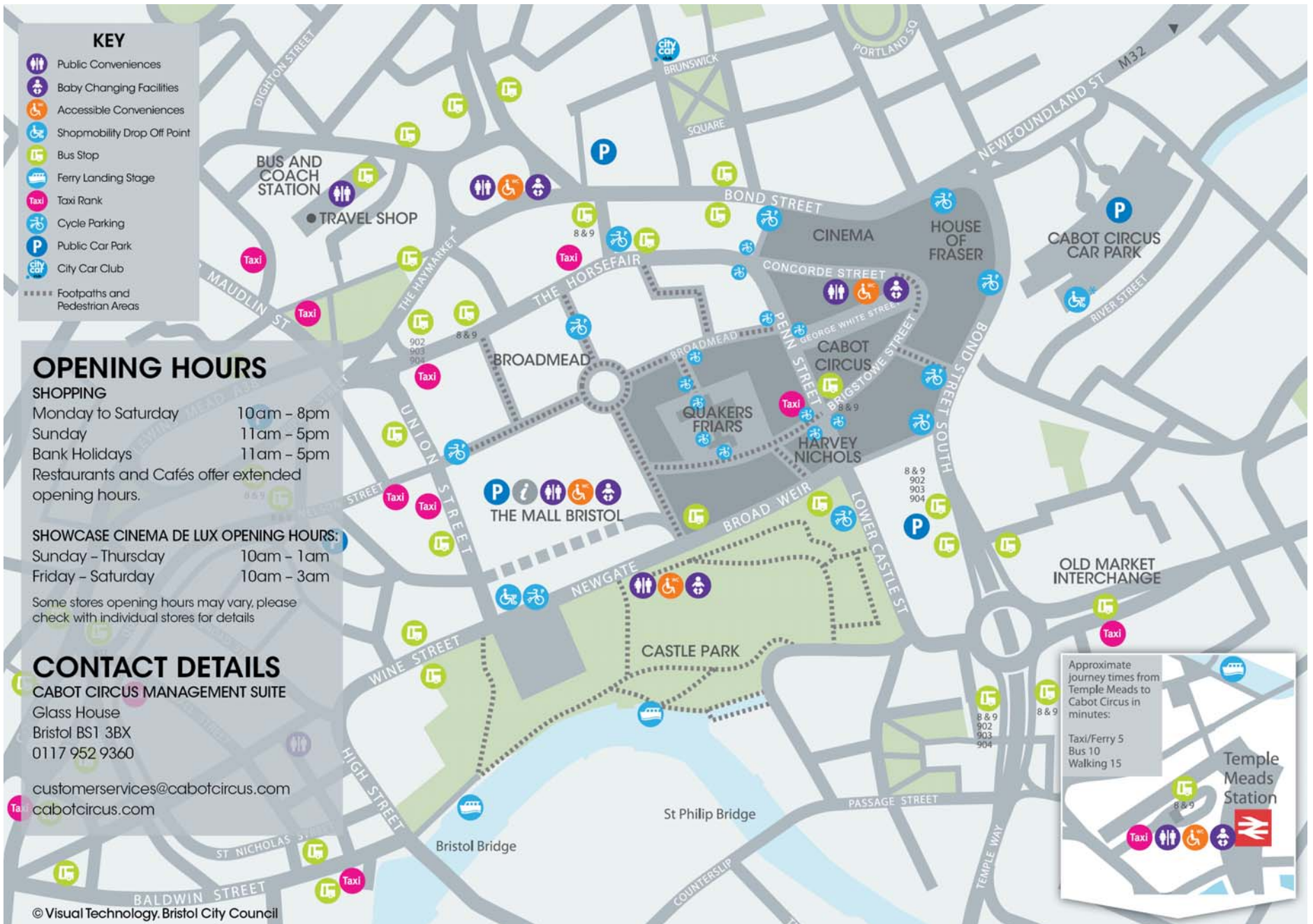
